

## What Next - FAQs

Do I need a costume?

YES. All teen participants will have a role in the 20-minute evangelistic drama "Toymaker's Son." You will be assigned a specific costume that you'll be responsible to bring but not necessarily wear yourself. Big World will send out your costume assignment in May with specifics of what that includes. You can check out photos of each costume and detailed costume list below.

Once we get to Miami, you'll find out what role you'll be playing in our drama, and costumes will be exchanged among your teammates. We'll be able to make minor sizing adjustments, but if you follow the directions you'll receive for your costume, it will work! we promise!

\*If you don't bring the costume you're assigned, you will be required to pay for us to find something in Miami, which is difficult and time consuming for your leaders.

What's Guatemala like?

Antigua Guatemala is a nation rich in history, famed for its friendly people, native arts and crafts, natural beauty and vast diversity of wildlife. The most populous of the Central American republics, the country is bordered by Mexico, Belize, Honduras and El Salvador- a rugged highland with high mountains that extend east and west. Guatemala's famed Maya ruins is a popular tourist draw as well as the incredible rain forests and jungles that abound in birds and other wildlife as well as unique tropical flora. \* What's the weather like in Antigua in July?

May through October is the rainy season in Guatemala & will be hot and humid with a possibility of afternoon rain.

Where will we stay?

The trip begins in Miami, Fla. with 3 days of drama training before we go to Guatemala. While in Florida, we'll stay at a local hotel, typically the Embassy Suites. While in Antigua Guatemala, our entire group will stay at a resort-type hotel that is large enough to accommodate and feed us all. Detailed information to come.
